Ironwood, also known as toa wood (casuarina equisetifolia or she-

oak)

Description
Tongan club, paddle type. Tongan term: 'Akau' or 'Pakipaki.' Likely used for ceremonial purposes due to its paddle-like shape. Similar clubs with blunt ends were used for war.
