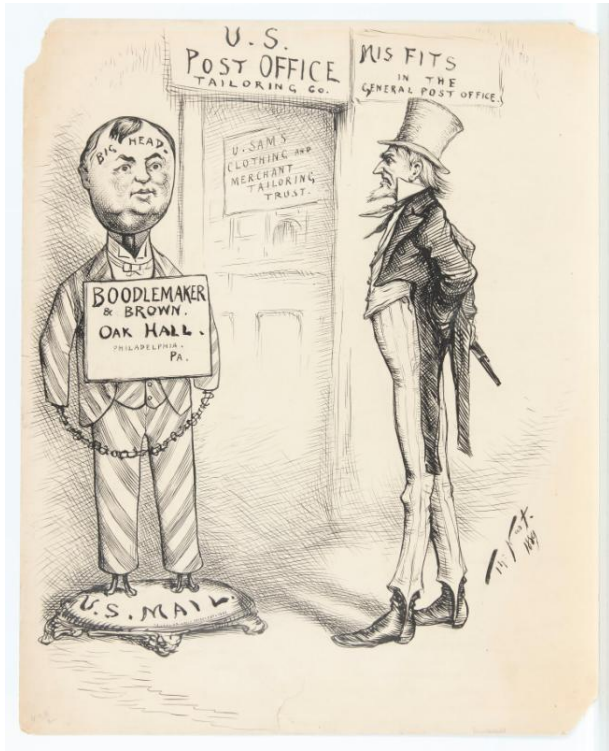




## U.S. Post Office Tailoring Company
