Description

Photograph of Room of the Signatura, one of the four Stanze of Raphael (Raphael Rooms) situated on the second floor of the Pontifical Palace (now part of the Vatican Museums). These

rooms were chosen by Julius II della Rovere (pontiff from 1503 to 1513) as his own residence and used also by his successors. The frescoes were executed by Raphael and his school between 1508 and 1524. This photo shows The School of Athens (East wall; on the right half of the photo) and The Parnassus (North wall; on the left half of the photo).
