From the portfolio forward: "Haines attended the School of the Museum of Fine Arts after studying anthropology and psychology at the University of Colorado and earning a degree from the Harvard Business School. He works in bronze cast from wax models, making pieces ranging from palm-sized to over six feet tall. The artist's sources include animal and figurative forms and the shapes of ancient tools and ceremonial objects. Peter Haines' print is formed from multiple layers of semi-opaque ink silkscreened onto acid-free rag vellum."
