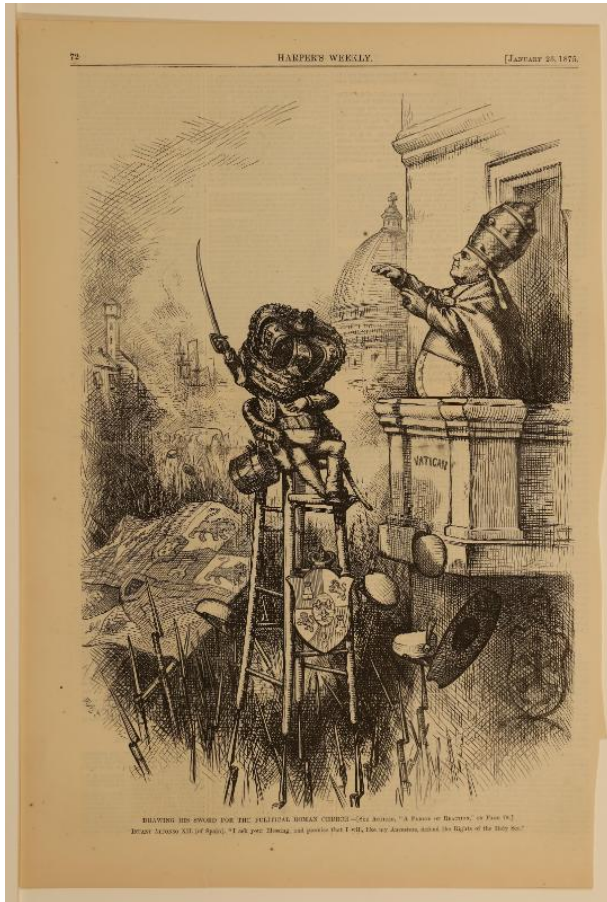




## Drawing His Sword for the Political Roman Church, from "Harper's Weekly"
