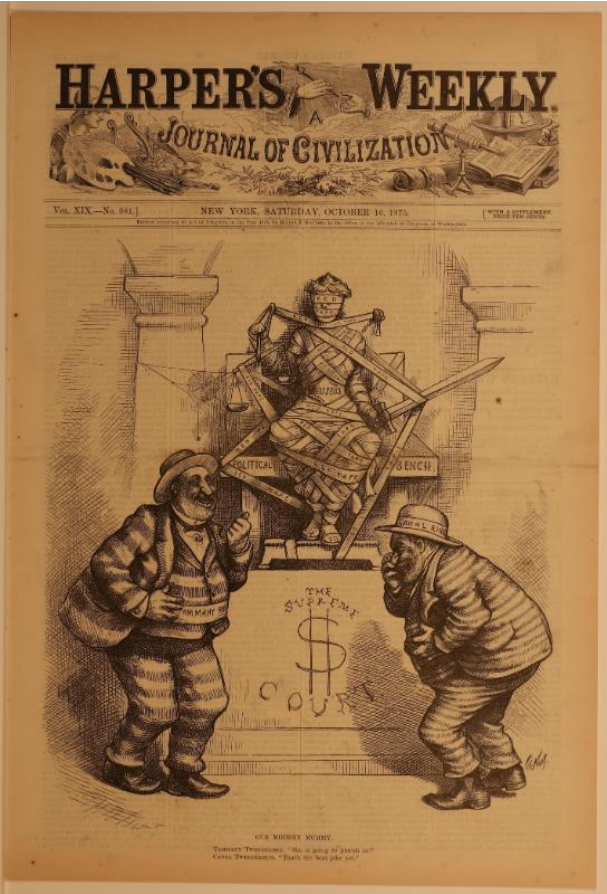




Our Modern Mummy, from "Harper's Weekly"
