2nd-3rd century CE

Mold-blown glass

**Description**

Pink translucent glass with surface varying from purple to blue and yellow. Cylindrical neck; body flattened to form four almost exactly equal rectangular faces. Bottom flat. Similar types referred to as "Mercury" bottles. Neck and mouth missing
